Suggested trim the edge of pitch.

9.30 start for finals to facilitate fairness away from due & 2 day event

- Late January Round 8, Umpires concerned with handling of matters. Had had a meeting with umpires to document process ie need a written report. One report in Round 8 and acted upon.
- Strategies for managing growth – last 4 years or so 6% growth. Is this going to continue. Possibly at top of cycle of 160 teams (which is max can cope with), need to start planning as we may be short of fields. Strategies:
 - Increase # of fields using Miranda Park (2 potentials)
 - New fields maybe at Kurnell (up to 3 fields). No others, school sites Cronulla High, Preston for 10A fields
 - Look at different format for different time zones
 - Emergencies – 16D's play 50 overs
 - Emergencies – 14 players per team
 - Max number in each age group
 - Suggestions for new pitches welcome
