Competition Manager – Tom Croucher

- Update on grounds

New pitches Caringbah PS & Endeavour HS

Grounds for development - all nets Scylla Bay, repair nets Seymour, Caringbah PS, Endeavour HS all \$40k approx. Funding from clubs required to assist in getting repairs done. Request at Council to get more money.

Council - keen to try 3 all season pitches. Need to choose fields that all sports are interested in.

No funding confirmed so all above to be advised.

- Team nominations

Closing date for association Sunday 24/8/07 (extra week). This is the latest – grading commences at 6pm that night. Preliminary details to Tom as early as possible. Gradings by Friday 29/8.

Experiment this year that Tom will be sending clubs computer ranking / grading to assist in clubs with discussing gradings before season commences. Will come out that Sunday to be finalised by the Friday.

U/8s should be loosely graded to ensure equitable competition & to assist association

Reports on coaches qualifications etc. Allows club to manage this issue

This year, teams created will match last year. Modify from there before the nominations deadline, need to confirm overs that the team will play. This will advise committee of grading intents. U/12's can still request modified cricket but unlikely to be allowed. Also requested team to nominate home ground.

- Changes to regulations

Been put forward from Presidents / Secretaries & approved by Exec Committee. As per email 4/7/08. Meeting to vote.

1. Allowance for a 6 to be scored in all ages. APPROVED
2. If you play 3 games in higher grade (or grade cricket), they stay in the same team. If circumstances change eg if dropped by grade, then letter to association for reinstatement. APPROVED
3. Reduce time before start of play for toss to occur to a minimum 10 minutes. APPROVED
4. Teams arranging a 1 day match if knowing they are short well in advance & the other club is in agreement. Accepting club receives 3 points even if loses game. A win achieves full points. Making this a permanent regulation. APPROVED
5. Loss of time on 1st day not due to light or condition of ground, now adding serious injury (injury report to be submitted). Added “or other reason accepted by the competition manager”. APPROVED
6. No closing fielding inside 10 metres apart from point, slips, wicketkeeper for U/14's & below. U/16's to have helmet & protectors. Much discussion from Como on not applying this to 14A, 14B & 12A's. This was voted on and APPROVED. Compromise suggested that 60 over traditional only & therefore not voted on.
7. Removing a rule difficult to administer ie number of matches played, modifying the requirement for a “full duration of a match”. Now changed to on team sheet & legitimately recorded on the score sheet as participated in the match. APPROVED

New regs will be on line by end of week.

Grade Club - Peter Smith

Request from Presidents / Secretaries meeting for development assistance. Grade club will use their development money. Grade Club will organise someone, clubs to contact Peter Smith. Process to be clarified over the next few weeks. Will be a Monday, Wednesday or Friday.

Representative Update – Greg

DCA competition, 5 games before Xmas, semi finals after Xmas. Change this year will be that the competition will be 19/10 – 14/12. No weeks off before Xmas. Will be on web site this week.

Rep noms close Tuesday 9th September. Trials 14/9 & 21/9. Details on venue & times to follow.

Winter Development programme will be for U/12 & U/13's. Squad will be confirmed over the next week, trials in August every Friday. High level coaches organised.

Clothing will be outsourced to Harry Solomans at Menai. Players expected to buy all uniform (playing & training). Different uniform this year. Rep fees \$65 (down from \$130) but clothing to be bought at \$75. Coaches provided clothes at same premises. Supporter shirt TBC.

Grade Club – Paul Lynne

Being brought forward to accommodate other cricket duties. Trials to commence 24/8, 31/8 & 5/9. Selectors named with SSJCA representation.

Technically kids U/14 up eligible ie 2nd year 14's only. Green Shield will go through to end of January.

Academy takes 22 students. Deadline closes 5/8/08.
